New Member Class – Jayesh Maniar, Vice President of the RTAM Board of Directors moves that: "The RTAM Board of Directors move to create a new member class, known as the Education Community Members. This membership class will be open to retired members of the education community with a minimum of 5 years of service. This membership category will allow full inclusion to the RTAM benefits plan(s), RTAM Chapters and Special Interest Groups in addition to RTAM events. The Education Community Members will not allow for members to serve on the Board of Directors, nor to vote at an RTAM Annual General Meeting (AGM). The inclusion on the Board and at the AGM is reserved for members in the Full Member class only and not the Education Community Members class".

4.01 D) Education Community Member membership in RTAM shall be available to:

i. A retired individual who has worked within a school, college, university or education learning facility within Manitoba as part of the education community for a minimum of 5 years;

- Education Community members are not voting members of RTAM and as such may not vote on formal matters of RTAM business or take any position with the RTAM Board of Directors.
- Any person qualified for such membership shall become an Education Community Member upon payment of the set membership fee.
