


Student Awards Program

- Allows member an opportunity learn about passions of their family member


Benefits to Student

THE STUDENT SUCCESS PORTFOLIO IS DESIGNED TO ENCOURAGE STUDENTS TO DEVELOP A PORTFOLIO TO COLLECT THEIR ARTIFACTS IN GRADE 9 THROUGH 12 WHICH ARE OF VALUE IN APPLYING FOR THE STUDENT AWARDS AND OTHER SCHOLARSHIOS, BUTSERIES, AND AWARDS.

- A portfolio serves as a physical framework to support the collection of samples of evidence significant to meeting RTAM Student Award requirements as well as for other awards, bursaries, and scholarships.
- The development of a portfolio supports students to collectively organize all their achievements, leadership skills, and experiences over their four years of high school.
- When students are involved in setting goals that are important to them, they gain a sense of responsibility for their own learning. Students become active and insightful learners about their own personal growth and skills.
